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## MULTIRESISTANT MRSA NEWLY CONFIRMED: 10-16 April 2004

### HEALTHCARE FACILITY

- Auckland City Hospital: 3 patients with EMRSA-15 strain, including 1 emergency department patient and 1 outpatient clinic patient.
- Middlemore Hospital: 2 patients: 1 with AKh4 MRSA;  
1 with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Starship Children's Health, Auckland: 1 patient with WR/AK1 strain.
- Auckland healthcare facilities †: 2 patients: 1 with AKh4 MRSA;  
1 with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Waikato Hospital: 2 patients with EMRSA-15 strain, including 1 in Ward 14, Surgical, and 1 post-discharge from Rotorua Hospital.
- Hawkes Bay Hospital: 3 patients with EMRSA-15 strain, including 2 outpatient clinic patients.
- Nelson Hospital: 1 patient, who is a healthcare worker from the United States.
- Timaru Hospital: 1 outpatient clinic patient with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Dunedin Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain.

### HEALTHCARE FACILITY (but patient in isolation from time of admission)

- Palmerston North Hospital: 1 patient, from Australia, with AKh4 MRSA.
- Christchurch Hospital: 1 patient with EMRSA-15 strain, transferred from Hawkes Bay Hospital.

### COMMUNITY

- Auckland: 2 people: 1 with AKh4 MRSA isolated during pre-employment screening;  
1 with EMRSA-15 strain.
- Waikato: 1 person with WR/AK1 strain.

## CURRENT OUTBREAKS OF NON-MULTIRESISTANT MRSA

Non-multiresistant EMRSA-15 (ciprofloxacin-resistant, erythromycin-susceptible) were newly isolated from 2 patients in Middlemore Hospital; 1 patient in an Auckland healthcare facility †; 1 patient in a Hawkes Bay healthcare facility †; and 4 pre-employment screens of healthcare workers, including 2 from the United Kingdom, and 1 who has previously worked at Middlemore Hospital.
